- Translations and original works in all languages are welcome. Translator must have appropriate permissions.
- Photography/Artwork up to 3 images

- Microsoft Word (or compatible) or pasted into the email.
- No PDFs.
- Photography/Artwork: high-resolution digital images (jpg preferred), related to Dorchester encouraged.
